

Snowflake Ornament

Appliqué / Embroidery Pattern
approx. 4" round or square

Stitched by machine or hand, the snowflake ornament is a delightful gift. We prepared a snowflake sample by machine with Aurifil Cotton 40wt and one by hand with Aurifil Cotton 8wt. LeAlpi offerings for machine and hand finishes are plentiful. Choose from Aurifil 100% Cotton in 28wt, 40wt, or 50wt for machine stitching, or 8wt or 12wt for hand stitching.

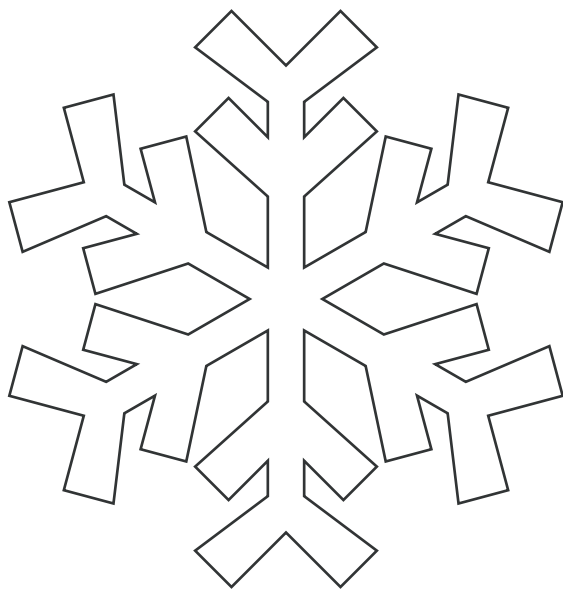
Round or Square Ornament with Snowflake Top

This ornament uses three (3) pieces of fabric: a front, a back, and a piece of fabric, wool, or felt for the snowflake.

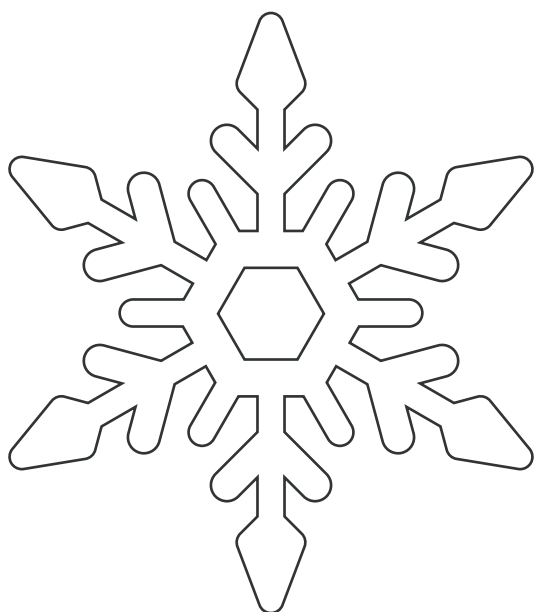
- [1] Print snowflake **and** square / circle templates (line art following pages)
- [2] Trace snowflake shape onto the dull side of a round or square piece of freezer paper
- [3] With dry iron, press freezer paper to right side of the chosen snowflake fabric, wool, or felt
- [4] Cut snowflake on the line & peel away the freezer paper
NOTE: serrated edge scissors work great for this
- [5] Glue or baste the snowflake to a circle or square of background fabric
- [6] Stitch the snowflake to the background fabric by hand or machine
NOTE: Cotton 8wt & 12wt work great for hand stitching; Cotton 28wt, 40wt, & 50wt work great for machine stitching
- [7] Add a backing fabric with wrong sides together; secure a ribbon or thread hanger between the fabrics
- [8] Sew around the perimeter of the ornament by hand or machine— leave a small opening for stuffing
- [9] Stuff with a soft fill and close opening by machine or hand
- [10] *Enjoy*

Note:

If preferred, a double sided fusible like Lite Steam-A-Seam2® can be used with the snowflake templates in place of freezer paper. There's no need to reverse the snowflake design.

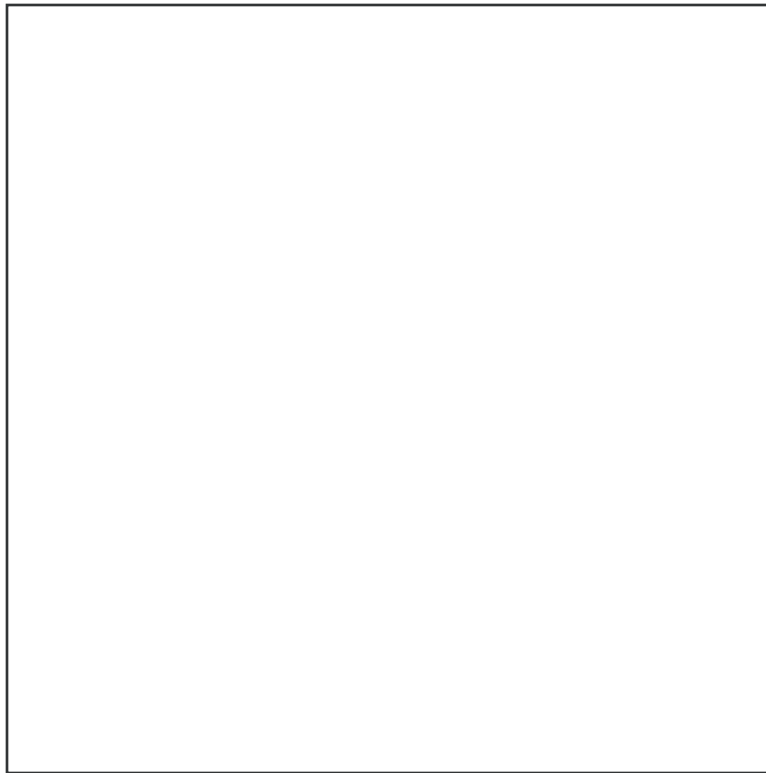


snowflake approx. 3" diameter

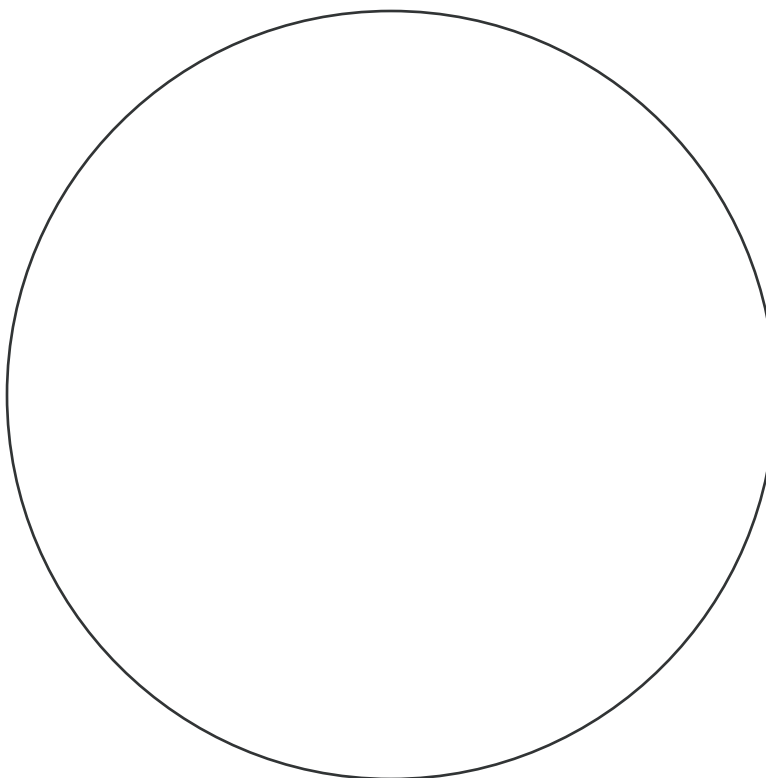


snowflake approx. 3" diameter
