

X-mas Tree FPP

Foundation Paper Piecing Pattern / Quilt Block, Mini Quilt, Decorative Embellishment
raw block 4½" x 4½" / finished block 4" x 4"
for bonus project— raw block 6½" x 6½" / finished block 6" x 6" (last page)
FPP pattern & color reference next page

Fabric Requirements

[3] 2½" x 1½" rectangles for A1 Orange, B2 BKG, & C3 BKG (bonus project— [3] 3½" x 2½")

[1] 4" x 4" square for D4 Green (bonus project— [1] 6" x 6")

[2] 3" x 6" rectangles for E5 BKG & F6 BKG (bonus project— [2] 5" x 8")

NOTE: you can use scraps for this block if you wish, using fabric requirements as a rough guide.

FPP Templates

When printing out the X-mas Tree template (next pages), *ensure the printer is set to "100% scale", "actual size", or scaling "none". 1" test square included.* Once printed, use a quilting ruler to check the dashed line (¼" seam allowance) measures 5" square (or 7" square for the bonus project), this is the raw size of the block.

Cut the template a comfortable distance outside of the dashed line. After you have sewn all the sections together, trim to desired size by cutting to the raw or finished size.

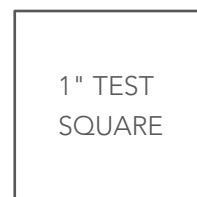
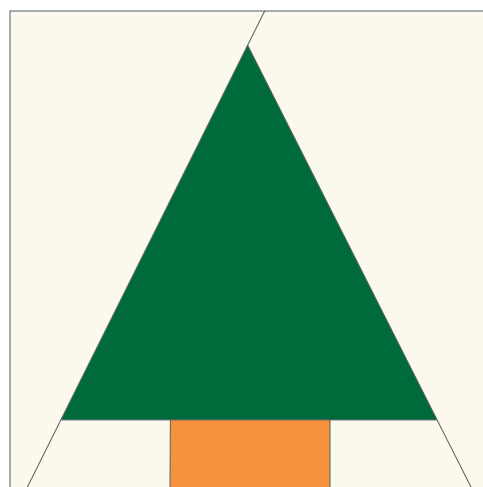
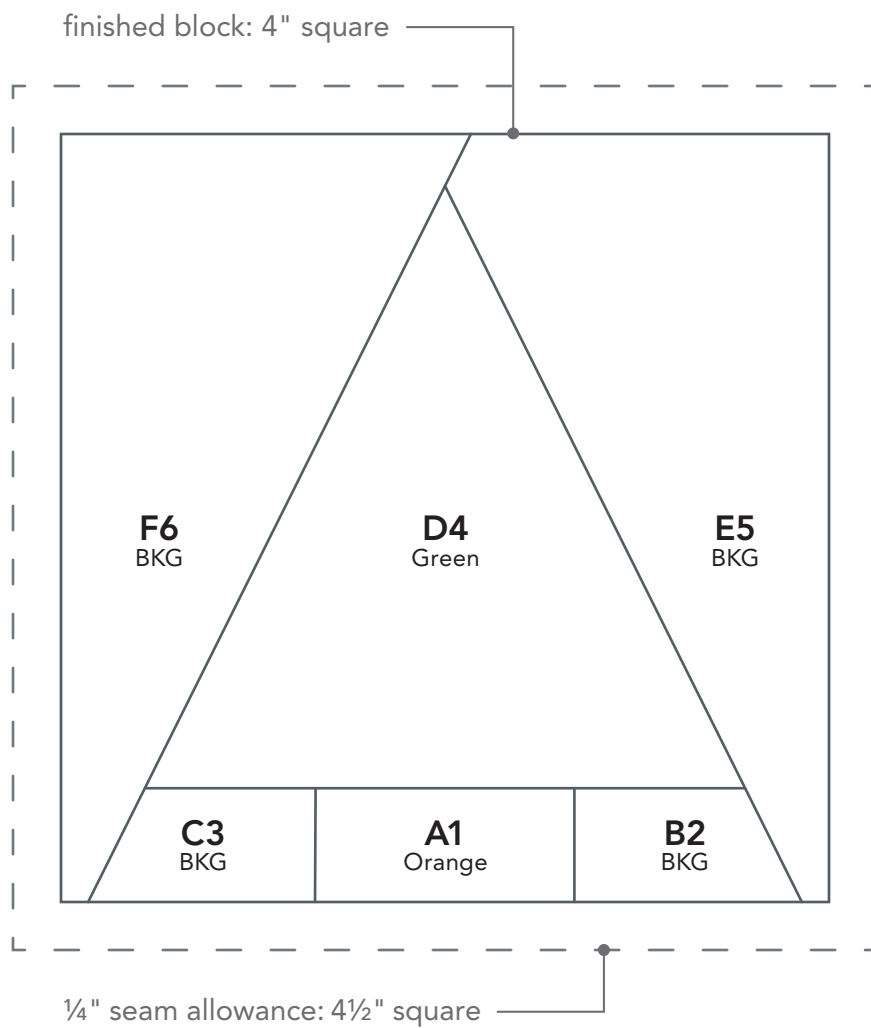
Join Sections in this order (by the number)—

A1 > B2 then A1+B2 > C3 then A1+B2+C3 > D4 then A1+B2+C3 + D4 > E5 then finish with A1+B2+C3 + D4 + E5 > F6

Tips & Tricks

- Shorten your stitch length.
- Backstitch the start and end of each line to ease the ripping of the paper at the end.
- Iron each seam as you go to keep your work neat.
